National Central University Graduate Institute of Astronomy Regulations Governing Master's and Doctoral Degree Requirements*

Approved at the Institutional Affairs Committee Meeting on 10th April, 2012 Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on 20th June, 2012 Revised and Approved at the Institutional Affairs Committee Meeting on 18th June, 2013 Appraised and ratified at the Academic Affairs Committee Meeting on 16th October, 2013

- Article 1 These regulations are provided in accordance with the National Central University Rules Governing the Master's and Doctoral Degree Qualifying Exam and Thesis Defense Article 2.
- Article 2 Master's students are expected to earn at least 24 credit hours during their course of study; doctoral students are expected to earn at least 18 credit hours; direct-entry doctoral students are expected to earn at least 34 credit hours (of which at least 18 must be credit hours earned from doctoral courses).
- Article 3 Master's students are expected to take and pass the following required courses: Observational Astronomy, Stellar Atmosphere and Structure, Astrophysics of Galaxies, Seminar I and II. Students must submit a master's thesis and pass the oral defense of the thesis. Those who fail these requirements shall not be allowed to graduate.
- Article 4 Doctoral students are expected to complete the requirements of this Institute's Guidelines Governing Doctoral Degree Qualifying Examination and Graduation Requirements. Those who fail these requirements shall not be allowed to graduate.
- Article 5 Master's and doctoral students are expected to take courses offered by this Institute. Without the approval of this Institute, courses taken outside the Institute shall not be considered as graduation credits.
- Article 6 Students who have taken courses offered by this Institute before their enrollment in the Institute are eligible to apply for credit waiver in accordance with the Course Credit Waiver Guidelines for Students in the Graduate Institute of Astronomy at National Central University.
- Article 7 Matters not covered by these guidelines shall be conducted in accordance with relevant rules and regulations by the Ministry of Education and the University.
- Article 9 These regulations shall be implemented and entered into force upon approval by a Meeting of the Institute Affairs Committee and appraisal and ratification by a meeting of the Academic Affairs Committee. The

same procedure applies to any amendment of these regulations.
